Scholarships & Grants

- Each year USHJA awards thousands of dollars in grants and scholarships for both Educational and Equestrian Goals
- Zone based grants & scholarships: Visit your individual <u>Zone</u> Grants & Scholarships page for details. Many Zones offer both Educational and EAP scholarships.
- <u>\$25,000 Hamel Family Scholarship</u>: Awarded to one or more applicants for college, graduate, trade, or professional school.
- <u>Alvin Topping Governance Grant</u>: One \$500 grant is awarded annually to assist one USHJA member, 25 years of age or under) with funding to support their attendance at the USHJA or USEF annual meeting.
- <u>J.T. Tallon Memorial Equitation Grant</u>: Each year, the USHJA Foundation will grant \$1,000 to one junior rider who has qualified for a national equitation championship at a fence height of 3' or higher.
- <u>Gochman Grant for USEF Pony Finals</u>: This grant is not strictly monetary in nature, but rather experience-based. In addition to the opportunity to compete at USEF Pony Finals, each grant recipient is provided access to professionals for training; entered into available clinics; and exposed to other educational experiences throughout the week.
- <u>Affiliate Organization Grant</u>: Affiliate Organizations can apply for up to \$500 for event, scholarship and/or clinic support. Deadline to apply October 4, 2021. Contact <u>Melanie Mader</u> for an application

USHJA Affiliate National Championships

- This is an opportunity for Affiliate Organizations to send riders to a National Championship designed just for them.
- The <u>USHJA Affiliate Championships</u> will include expanded offerings for 2021, for Juniors and Amateurs in the Hunters and Equitation at fence heights of 2' and 2'6" and Jumpers from .70m to .90m. Thirty (30) riders will be accepted for each section. View <u>Specifications</u>
- Affiliate Organizations can nominate 3 riders to participate in each section. Riders do not need to be members of USHJA to participate. Horses are not required to be recorded with USHJA.
- Riders may be nominated to cross enter in the same height section for a different Affiliate Division (ie, Hunters 2' and Equitation 14 & Under 2') Horses may compete with a different rider in a different height section.
